January 3, 2023

The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9 AM on Tuesday, January 3, 2023, with Chairman Jim Cary, Vice-Chair Shane McCampbell and Member Tom Broeker present. This meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Organization of the 2023 Board of Supervisors was conducted. Cary made a motion to nominate McCampbell for Chair, Broeker for Vice-Chair and was seconded by Broeker. The meeting was then conducted by Chairman Shane McCampbell.

Judge Joshua Schier administered the oath of office to appoint Sara Doty as County Auditor. Doty will serve the balance of Terri Johnson's term until after the canvass of votes for either a petitioned Special Election to fill the vacancy or when the seat appears on the November 5, 2024 General Election.

Public Hearing for FY23 Budget Amendment. Broeker made a motion to open the public hearing and seconded by Cary. Budget Director Cheryl McVey presented and explained the budget amendment request. Broeker asked Auditor Doty if any comments had been received. None received. Broeker made a motion to close the public hearing and seconded by Cary. Cary motioned to approve the FY23 Budget Amendment and seconded by Broeker.

Resolution #2023-003 Appointing Board of Health Members was presented. Jeff Heland, Dr. Frances Jackson, Mack Turner, and Deb Trousil requested re-appointments with a term to expire in January, 2026. Cary made a motion to approve and seconded by Broeker.

Accounts Payable claims in the amount of \$226,469.42 were presented. Broeker made a motion to approve and seconded by Cary.

Approval of 2023 Board Committee Assignments was presented. Cary will now be assigned to DHLW Early Childhood Area Board and McCampbell will be assigned to Des Moines County Conservation. All other assignments remained the same. Broeker made a motion to approve and seconded by Cary.

Approval of 2023 Condemnation Commissioners list was presented. Cary made a motion to approve and seconded by Broeker.

Approval of Official Newspapers for 2023 was presented. Broeker made a motion to approve Des Moines County News, The HawkEye, Mediapolis News, and The Burlington Beacon as Official Newspapers and seconded by Cary.

City of Burlington requested a Tax Abatement for Parcel #16-05-263-005. Cary made a motion to approve and seconded by Broeker.

Broeker made a motion to approve and seconded by Cary. Local Health – Senitra Donaldson, PT RN, Promoted to FT RN, \$52,564.68 yearly effective 1/3/23. Cary made a motion to approve and seconded by Broeker. Secondary Roads – David Lloyd, Assistant to the Engineer, Retirement effective 12/31/22; Devon Bell, Assistant to the Engineer, Increase salary to \$75,000.00 yearly effective 1/3/23. Cary made a motion to approve both and seconded by Broeker.

Sheriff's Report of Fees Collected, November 2022

Broeker motioned to approve the December 20th, 2022 regular meeting minutes and seconded by Cary.

Meet with Department Heads: Sheriff Kevin Glendening introduced new hires Theresa Tripp, Administrative Assistant and Joshua Fane, Deputy. Jail population is at 86. Public Health Director Christa Poggemiller reported her office remains busy with vaccines. Land Use Administrator Zach James reported the office has a couple subdivisions to be recorded. The Wind and Solar Ordinance needs to be reviewed after budget meetings this week. County Attorney Lisa Schaefer stated her office is busy getting back to trial after the holidays. County Engineer Brian Carter stated Highway 99 Bridge construction should start back up today. The bridge work on 165th Avenue should start soon as well. Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener reported he has been short staffed due to illness, so he is working hard to get things caught up. Budget Director Cheryl McVey reported budget hearings will begin today. SEIL CDS Director Ken Hyndman gave a SEIL update. Conservation Director Chris Lee reported the ice on the ponds is not as frozen as it has been with the warmer temperatures. Please be cautious anytime during the winter when going on the ice. Conservation held a winter camp at Starr's Cave last week and they had a great turn out. County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist reported the office is busy. Auditor Sara Doty would like to thank everyone for the support through the transition of Terri retiring. Doty is currently working on getting a new Payroll Deputy hired for the office.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:52 AM.
