CONTRACT BETWEEN DES MOINES COUNTY AND DEPUTY COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER FOR SERVICES

This Contract is by and between the Des Moines County Board of Supervisors (hereinafter the "Board") and Dr. Rose Schabilion for Deputy County Medical Examiner services for deaths occurring in Des Moines County, Iowa that are under the jurisdiction of the Medical Examiner.

WHEREAS, the Board authorized Dr. Rose Schabilion to act as a Deputy Medical Examiner for Des Moines County by Resolution.

WHEREAS, Dr. Rose Schabilion is willing and able to provide such services for the benefit of Des Moines County and states that she meets the qualifications to serve as a Deputy County Medical Examiner as set out under Iowa Code Chapters 331 and 144.

IT IS THEREFORE MUTUALLY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HEREIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Dr. Rose Schabilion shall serve as the Deputy County Medical Examiner (hereinafter "DCME") for the benefit of Des Moines County.

The DCME shall maintain all records of the Medical Examiner consistent with Iowa Law.

The DCME the following duties as directed:

- 1. All duties as required by law including but not limited to those duties enumerated in Code of Iowa Chapters 331 and 144.
- 2. Coordinate arrangements for autopsy when needed.
- 3. Review and deny or approve cremation permits as provided in Iowa Code Chapter 331. The Deputy County Medical Examiner may charge a fee for a cremation permit not to exceed the statutory maximum allowed by Iowa law. Such fee shall be paid by a decedent's estate, next of kin, family, or guardian.
- 4. In the event this contract is terminated, the DCME shall turn over all records in her possession to the County Attorney to hold until a replacement Medical Examiner is appointed by the board of supervisors.
- 5. The DCME shall be an independent contractor and shall not be deemed to be an employee of the county.
- 6. CME or DCME shall be available on-call 24/7 and able to respond timely to a death within the jurisdiction.
- 7. If the CME is the treating physician for a person who dies and the death is within the jurisdiction of the CME, the DCME shall be assigned to investigate the death.

The County shall perform the following Duties:

- 1. Des Moines County Iowa Agrees to pay the CME and/or the DCME \$200 for each death investigation performed, with the examiner conducting the exam receiving payment. Each payment will be made directly to the examiner performing the investigation.
- 2. The County shall adopt a resolution approving the CME and DCME.
- 3. The county shall separately contract with Medical Examiners Investigators (herein after MEI) to serve at the direction of the CME and DCME. Payment of fees to the MEIs shall be paid separately and are not covered under the fees provided herein.
- 4. County shall separately pay the fees and cost of any autopsy requested by the CME and/or DCME. All such autopsy shall be referred to the University of Iowa Decedent Care Unit or the State Medical Examiner unless stipulated elsewise by the County Attorney.

Term and Termination:

- 1. This Contract for services shall commence on November 19, 2024 and shall be in effect until the end of the first prorated term ending June 30, 2025 in accordance with Iowa Code Section 331.801. This Contract for services shall automatically renew at ongoing two-year intervals unless otherwise modified or terminated in writing by the parties.
- 2. Amendments or modifications to this contract shall be in writing, signed by all parties hereto.
- 3. Renegotiation of the terms of this contract if any shall commence 120 days before and end 60 days before the end of the fiscal year for the state of Iowa. Essentially creating a renegotiation window consisting of the Month of March 1st through April 30th of any given year.
- 4. Any party may terminate this services contract for any reason with 120 days advance written notice.

Liability:

- 1. Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 670.8, the County shall defend, save harmless and indemnify Medical Examiner and/or Deputy County Medical Examiner against any tort claim demand, whether groundless or otherwise, arising out of an alleged act or omission occurring within the scope of his/her duties.
- 2. However, this agreement to save harmless and indemnify, does not apply to awards for punitive damages, or to willful and wanton acts or omissions made by the CME or DCME.

Restitution:

1. Any restitution ordered in a criminal case for medical exam fees, including but not limited to fees paid hereunder, autopsy fees, MEI fees, and lab fees that were paid by the County shall be ordered to be repaid to the County.

Miscellaneous:

1. In the event CME and/or DCME does not request autopsy in a death investigation, but in the course of investigation takes blood, tissue, or other samples for laboratory analysis, CME and/or DCME shall submit such samples to the Iowa Division of Criminal Investigation if the matter is under criminal investigation by law enforcement.
